SUBJECT: Updated COVID-19 Facial Covering Requirements

---

Effective immediately, masks are not required on MTS vehicles and in stations and concourses. This applies to both customers and employees in these spaces. Per CDC and TSA guidance, MTS continues to recommend masking on the system.

MTS will continue to make N-95 masks available to all employees and any employee may choose to wear a facial covering while at work. **These changes do not impact employees who have been approved to return to work following a positive COVID-19 test or exposure to COVID-19.** Employees who have been exposed or have tested positive must continue to follow the facial covering protocols outlined in my Return to Work Guidance memo dated January 6, 2022, which can be found on the COVID-19 pages on the MTS website.

Lastly, MTS will continue to offer free, on-site COVID-19 testing to all employees.
